Recycling is Mandatory in CT, It’s the Law
Law: Pursuant to CT General Statutes sec. 22a-220(f), 22a-229, 22a-241b. Failure to recycle may be subject to fines and potential civil enforcement action.

- What can I place in single stream recycling?
ALL FOOD MUST BE RINSED OUT!
• Bottles (from food products and beverages)
• Cans (from food or beverages)
• Cardboard / boxboard (such as cereal boxes)
• Cartons (from food or beverages)
• Junk Mail
• Magazines/ Catalogs
• Newspaper (full sheets)
If it’s cut up – throw it into the trash
• Paper (white or colored) – full sheets
If it’s cut up – throw it in the trash
• Plastic (from food cartons, detergents or beverages)
• Tin foil trays and sheets

- Other Items recycled at RRDD1, in separate locations
• Batteries (auto, household, hearing aids)
• Brush / leaves / wood (no stumps)
• Clothing
• Electronics and Televisions
• Motor oil and anti-freeze (separate)
• Light bulbs
• Metal
• Mattress / Box Spring
• Paint (household oil and latex, no spray cans)
• Propane tanks – 20# ONLY
• Tag Sale (new or gently used items)
• Tires
• Wire

- Items NOT recyclable: (place in trash)
• Ceramic, pottery and other dish/cookware
• Paper plates, napkins, tissues and towels
• Plastic silverware and straws
• Plastic bags
• Plastic containers that contained chemicals
• Glass drinking cups/ dishes/ mirrors / windows
• Shredded Paper
• Styrofoam, paper and plastic beverage cups

- The Principles of the five R’s:
• Refuse to buy it if you don’t need it.
Don’t take the “freebie” if your not going to use it.
• Reduce what you buy or purchase in quantity to limit excess packaging
• Reuse instead of purchasing single use items, such as water bottles and metal straws
• Repurpose something old making a new item
• Recycle bottles, cans, cardboard, and newspapers

- Items NOT Accepted at RRDD1
o Asbestos
o Chemicals
o Explosives / Fireworks
o Hazardous waste materials of any nature
o Household cleaners
o Insecticides / Herbicides / Pesticides
o Lead based paints
o Medical or Pathological waste
o Mercury thermometers
o Paint thinners
o PCB’s
o Polyurethane
o Propane tanks (other than 20# units)
o Radio Active
o Radon
o Smoke detectors
o Varnish
o Weed killers
o Wood preservatives / strippers

Household Hazardous Waste Day
We are currently in the process of planning this event, to be held off site, in October. This event is of no charge to the residents BUT RRDD1 pays a premium for YOUR items! Its roughly \$35 per car, from the RRDD1 budget! Therefore, It’s not free! Plan accordingly when you purchase chemicals. Don’t overbuy. Give away what you don’t need.

Surveillance cameras are in use throughout the property for several reasons. If you are unsure of where something goes, ASK!

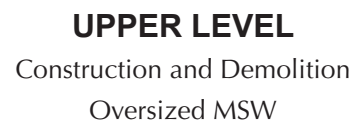
- The choice is yours:
• Carefully pack your household trash and recyclables in your vehicle and discard at RRDD1. You will need an annual or semi-annual sticker to do so. Stickers are available at the gate-house during regular daytime hours. Cash or check accepted ONLY. No debit cards.
• Hire a private service to pick up your trash and recyclables on a weekly basis. You pay all disposal rates.
• Hire a private service to pick up your trash but take your recyclables to RRDD1 on Wednesday between 4PM – 7PM.

All items coming into RRDD1 MUST be from within the towns listed above. Proof of residency is required.

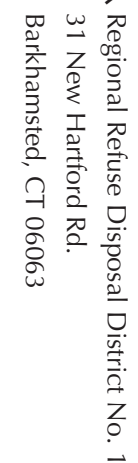
- What is a sticker all about?
• Fiscal year stickers are available to any resident of Barkhamsted, New Hartford or Winsted.
• Stickers may be purchased at the gatehouse during normal daytime hours of operation

Hours of Operation:
Monday: 7:00 AM – 3:00 PM
Wednesday: 7:00 AM – 3:00 PM
Night: 4:00 PM – 7:00 PM (lower level)
Friday: 7:00 AM – 3:00 PM
Saturday: 7:00 AM – 3:00 PM
CLOSED Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday

- Vehicle MUST be on site at time of sale
• Sticker MUST be affixed to lower left windshield
• Unlimited trips with sticker
• MUST abide by the rules and regulations set forth by RRDD1, failure to obey may lead to penalties / fines/ and/ or loss of sticker.
• Stickers include, at no extra fee, the disposal of YOUR kitchen food waste disposed of in the lower level trash compactors. Recyclables MUST be removed, per law. All other “debris” MUST be driven to the upper lot scale area, additional fees applicable
• Day Pass is available for \$20 per day plus debris fee
