## TRASH CRISIS IN CONNECTICUT

The current trash crisis in Connecticut has unfortunately caused us to raise our sticker fees and some of our scale prices. RRDD1 takes the majority of our waste and recycling to the MIRA run transfer station in Torrington. In Torrington the waste is loaded with the other MIRA towns and transported by truck to a landfill in Pennsylviania. With the Governor signing House bill 6664 in June of 2023 effectively ending the Materials Innovation and Recycling Authority (MIRA), This leaves the remaining MIRA member towns with uncertaintity with what it will cost to dispose of our waste and recycling and where it will go.

Beginning on July 1, 2024 it will cost RRDD1 \$131.00 per ton to dispose of our waste. This is an increase of \$15.00 per ton over the current year. With our MIRA contract we are not charged additional fees to dispose of our recycling. If we are forced to go with a private hauler in the future, we will be charged a fee for recycling. The long term effects of the state closing the MIRA trash to energy plant in Hartford will continue to be felt until an economical, sustainable and environmentally friendly solution is found.

At RRDD1 we continue to try and find ways to help reduce the amount of waste we send to the landfill. Programs such as our food scraps composting program and our upcoming STYROFOAM recycling program are just the start.
